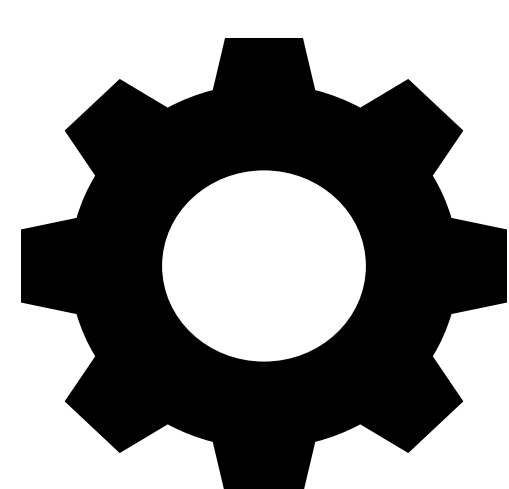

SUPPLY CHAIN INFLUENCE

By invitation, EALgreen became a voting member of Underwriter Laboratories (UL) in 2019 to create a new UL Technical Standard for the Circular Economy. The Reverse Logistics Association recognizes the EAL model as "a fresh voice in social innovation." The global business community with partners in China, Australia and Switzerland advocates for higher education by promoting the EAL business model.
